Boarding for your pooch!

Hi bushyeyebrows,

I send my 10 mth old beagle to a professional day care an boarding facility at Jinny Dog Care. The owners are US trained professional and they have a large indoor, cageless and fully air conditioned day care facility at Upper Thomson, near Springleave area. When I bought my beagle, I searched high and low for boarding services in Singapore, including many home-based boarding facility and professionally-run day care facility and I personally feel that home boarding is not suitable for my needs. Firstly some of the home boarding places were not totally dog/puppy proof to me, and many potential dangerous objects around within reach as my beagle is a very curious and greedy breed and will eat anything, some places have steep stairs etc. There was professional daycare/boarding facility I checked out and although they said they have staff on hand, I didn't see any staff interact with the dogs during the 2 hrs I was there and the dogs looked so bored and weren't playing at all.

I chanced upon Jinny Dog Care by chance and have been using them for past 3 mths. The dogs get to play together in door and is constantly supervised by staff at all times. I can could go online to view the webcam during the day to see what the dogs are up to. They are always happily running and chasing each other around. Owners will also take your dog for walk if require but they get sufficient exercise indoor as it is. Its really cute to watch them on web cam as the dogs really do not rest much as they are always playing with each other and with the staff.

If you require overnight dog boarding, they owners will bring the boarders home at night and bring them into the day care the next day. They will only bring maximum of 4 overnight boarders home at any one time. If there are more than 4 overnight boarders during peak season, the owners will then sleep over night at the day care together with the overnight doggies. I was a bit concern about home boarding once again but if you leave your pooch at day care and they were to bring them home at night, your pooch will be dead tired and will sleep through the night uneventfully.

I am so glad I found this place as my beagle comes home dead tired from playing all day and she is no longer as destructive and out-of-control as before.

When I go away on holiday, I will definitely leave them in the good hands of Ginny Dog Care.

Also, their charges are very reasonable and is cheaper from some of the places I have come across. Of course the Pet kennels and pet hotels are much cheaper but I wouldn't leave my dog there as I have had my cat come back with deadly disease and bad testimonials from friends who boarded dogs at pet kennels before.
